Our best to all: Heather, Zach, Keely, Harlow, baby Asher, and most of all Pawpaw who took the picture!



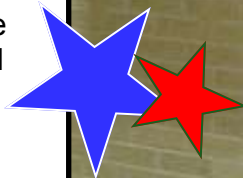
